There are many volunteer opportunities at the Humane Society. Volunteers can choose to work with cats or dogs or both. Dog attendants manage their charges by taking them for walks, cleaning the runs and interacting with the pets in the Paw Safari. Cat attendants clean litter boxes and cages, feed and give the felines water, and lavish them with love and attention through brushing and petting the animals

There are opportunities to help at special events the shelter has established, by selling HSOC merchandise or manning an information booth. There are clerical functions, help with sending mailings and memberships and follow-up phone calls.



THE SPIRIT OF GIVING

Not everyone who helps the animals at the Humane Society comes into the shelter to volunteer. Perhaps your hours are not flexible or you are too young to deal directly with the animals. The HSOC has many valuable supporters who collect food and supplies for the cats and dogs. Children forego gifts at their birthday parties and request donations be made instead to the shelter. Others set up bequests and name the Humane Society of Ocean City a beneficiary in their estate.

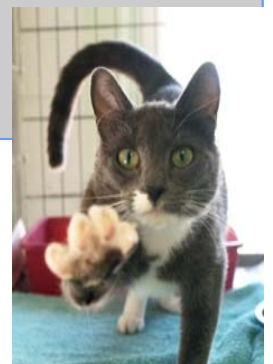
